Grant Award	Repairs to the roof of The Stanley Club, Burscough. This is a community, non profit making facility in Burscough, for the use by local residents and an asset to the community. If the roof had not been repaired the facility may have been deemed unsafe and a great loss to the local community	£5,000.00
Asset Improvements	This was replacement of broken and deemed unsafe benches which are assets belonging to Burscough Town Council and are for the use by the local community.	£2,760.00
